1. Will the video require a voiceover?

Please provide pricing for an animation video that includes a voiceover narration and for an animation that does not include a voiceover. The voiceover would need to be provided by the service provider.

2. If a voiceover is required, who will provide this (service provider or client)?

The service provider should plan on providing the voiceover.

6. What is the intended scope of distribution for this animation?

The animation video will primarily be distributed via US Ignite's website, us-ignite.org, and via social media channels. Additionally, the video animation link will be sent to partners and clients including municipal representatives, industry executives, and academics.
